Thank you for your interest in General Grant National Memorial.

Overlooking the Hudson River from the Morningside Heights section of Manhattan, General Grant National Memorial is the largest tomb in North America. Grant's Tomb (as it is commonly called) is not only the final resting place of the General but a memorial to his life and accomplishments. The site is an excellent setting for groups of all ages to explore the themes of American history, civic engagement, civil rights of native Americans and African Americans in the 19th Century, the Presidency of the United States, the Civil War, reconstruction, architecture, and memorialization of an iconic American hero. The site features the Mausoleum and an accompanying visitor center to the west, across Riverside Drive, that has a bookstore, interpretive exhibits, park film, and public restrooms.

Hours & Location:

General Grant National Memorial is located in Riverside Park at 122nd Street and Riverside Drive. The national memorial is open Wednesday through Sunday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. The site is closed Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Years Day. The Memorial is open all other federal holidays even if it is on a Monday or Tuesday. The mausoleum is not wheelchair accessible, however the visitor center is.

Admission:

General Grant National Memorial does not charge an admission or entrance fee.

Self-Guided Tours:

Self-guided tours of the Mausoleum are available Wednesday to Sunday 10 am to 5 pm, and the visitor center from 9 am to 5 pm

Ranger-Guided Tours and Education Programs:

Free ranger-guided tours and education programming are available to groups, clubs, organizations, and students with prior appointment, and typically last about one hour. Group size for guided tours is limited to 60 people. (If you group is larger than 60, You are invited to visit the site as a self-guided tour. Time slots are generally available on the hour between 9 am and 4 pm, Wednesday through Sunday. The tour/program typically consists of an introductory talk with a ranger, viewing the 20 minute park film, and then a site tour of the plaza and Mausoleum. Contact us if you need any other days, times, or program durations, or other special considerations.

Confirmation:

Approximately one week after receiving your request form, a confirmation letter will be sent to you via email. On the day of your field trip, please call us at (646) 670-7251 to confirm meeting place and time for your group.
